Infant and Toddler Program

We offer a unique approach to care for children 6 weeks to 36 months. It contains a balance of structured and children's choice activities that are both teacher directed and child directed. The concepts of early brain stimulation and early attachment theory are cornerstones of our program. Activities are developmentally appropriate and are planned to encourage creativity and help each child develop intellectually, physically, socially and emotionally at their own pace. Your child's day will include a wide variety of experiences including art, music, language, dramatic play, sign language, math, reading, science, large and small muscle activities and lots of fun!



Infant Program

Our Infant Program is designed to develop a strong relationship between the infant, the parents and the caregivers. Upon enrollment your child will receive a primary caregiver who serves as the main link to your child's daily experience.

You are encouraged to partner with your child's primary caregiver to develop an individual daily schedule that provides your child with a warm nurturing environment. Bi-weekly themes encourages even our youngest infants to be involved in early learning experiences.

Toddler Program

Our Toddler Program is designed for children 16 months to 36 months. Positive role-modeling and hands-on learning are keys to our program. Our staff works closely with all parents to ensure that the individual needs of each child is being met. The Toddler Program is structured to allow for small group as well as large group activities. Weekly theme-based curriculum makes it possible for children of different developmental stages to enjoy fun learning experiences.
