- 1. Bring all children inside to safe area(tornado shelter area)
- 2. Make sure all doors are secure
- 3. Lead teacher have cell phone for further instructions
- 4. Aid have Emergency kit and attendence

All children are safe. Director or Assistant Director will send out a communication to parent through Daily Connect or e-mail or by phone

#### **EVACUATION ROUTES/EXITS**

### **Notification**

Emergency cards will be kept in emergency back packs and at Infant Center

#### Release

Children will only be released to parents/guardians or other individuals listed on the child's form (with proper identification)

Children will be signed out on an attendance sheet that is kept in the emergency book in the emergency kit.
